

You can use this service if...

- You have difficulty using the bus;
- There is no bus service running when you need to travel;
- Getting to your medical appointment by car is difficult.

How do I use this service?

1. Telephone 023 8027 0088 to register and book.
2. You will be asked to provide the following information:
 - Name, address and telephone number;
 - Time and date of medical appointment/visit;
 - Name of hospital, medical centre or GP surgery visiting;
 - If wheelchair access is required.
3. If you only want to use the service for the return journey please telephone 023 8027 0088.

How much notice should I give?

You should provide as much as notice as possible, ideally two days prior to your appointment or visit. If you book your journey more than a month in advance, please telephone nearer to the day of travel to confirm your booking.

Hospital Car Service (Patient Transport Service)

It may be possible for you to use the Hospital Car Service free of charge. The doctor or consultant will be able to tell you if you are eligible for this service.

Eastleigh Medical Transport Service

The Eastleigh Medical Transport Service is a subsidised transport service supported by Eastleigh Borough Council which will collect you from your home and take you to any one of the listed hospitals, medical centres or GP surgeries.

This service is available seven days a week, if you are a patient attending a medical appointment or visiting friends and relatives in hospital.

This service will try to accommodate wheelchair users (please notify the operator at time of booking).
